

Subject: Union Bank and Trust MOVEit Security Incident Class Action Settlement

File your claim for up to \$100 or more by July 21, 2026

You may have recently received a mailed or emailed notice of a class action settlement in Massachusetts federal court regarding the Security Incident as it relates to Personally Identifiable Information (“PII”) of Union Bank and Trust clients (the “Settlement”). If so, according to the terms of that notice, you may be eligible to receive **either**: (1) reimbursement of ordinary losses up to \$2,500 and reimbursement of extraordinary losses up to \$10,000; **or** (2) an alternative cash payment of \$100 (subject to *pro rata* reduction or increase based on total claim submission)—in addition to two (2) years of identity theft protection services from the proposed Settlement. To receive a payment and/or identity theft protection services, you must complete and submit a Claim Form. You may file your claim online or complete and mail the downloadable claim form, which are both available on the website, www.ubtdatasettlement.com. Your Claim Form must be postmarked or submitted online by **July 21, 2026**.
